The organisations where people get health services need to change.

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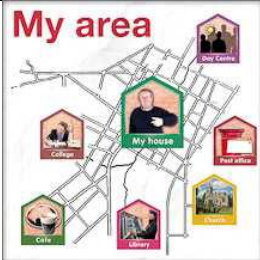
These organisations provide hospitals, mental health, learning disabilities and community care services.

Care can now be provided at home, or near to where people live. This works really well and people like it.



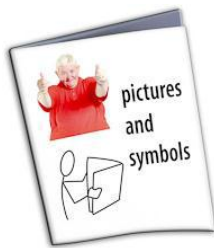
This costs more money.

We want more health checks.










We want more help when we leave hospital.

If you get very poorly you will go to the best hospital for your illness.

There are different ways that services can be changed






Some of the things we could do are;



Not change services. This will mean we need to think about changes in the future.



Make one hospital the place to go to in an emergency and the other where you would go to have treatment you knew you were going to have.

	<p>People who have bad burns or broken bones would be taken to their local hospital and looked after in an emergency.</p> <p>Then they would go to a different hospital for special treatment. Community services would not change.</p>
